For these reasons there is in place an efficient traceability system of FSC product according to FSC requirements **FSC-STD-40-004**.

A.D. Compound's Management undertakes to promote a good practices of forestry resources management that it is consistent with ethic-environmental values, cooperating with supplier and customer toward to social accountability.

## As A.D. Compound policy it is our commitment:

- Implementing and maintain a management system for Chain of Custody about products certified for the forestry traceability;
- Promoting FSC certification in order to consolidate a Sustainable Forestry Management with the respect of forestry standard and legislation;
- Increasing of supplying of the forestry raw material handled by responsible practices;
- Periodically training for personnel related to control of traceability system

As specified into FSC-POL-01-004, A.D. Compound undertakes, now and for the future, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal logging or illegal trade in timber or forest products;
- b) Violation of traditional and human rights during forestry operations;
- c) Destruction of highly conserved values during forestry operations;
- d) Significant conversions of forests to plantations or other non-forest uses;
- e) Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
- f) Violation of any of the fundamental ILO conventions as defined in the Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at ILO Work.
